Sergeant Follis:

This fax confirms our conversation of June 14, 2007, at 3:12 P.M. wherein you stated that the complaint I filed on 05/17/07 at 2:20 P.M. with the Houston Police Department's IAD under Issue Tracking Number 2007-29741 has been assigned to Sergeant Parrett with Criminal Investigations and that I can reach him at 713-308-1566.

What I understand from our conversation is that Sergeant Parrett handles IAD investigations for a number of departments within HPD including robbery, homicide and financial crimes among others.

To summarize why we met today, I came up to IAD because despite a court order, I have been unable to get my property back from HPD. Further, I have not been able to file a stolen vehicle report or a theft report for the property that was stolen from my home. Finally, given that I had a court order granting me possession of my home when I was arrested for trespassing on my property, I am unable to return to the property for fear that the same detective will simply arrest me again. Clearly he has no concern for what the courts decide.

You suggested that I not contact Sergeant Parrett until tomorrow because you were told that he had three other cases he was working. You instructed me to wait for his call and if I do not hear from him in the morning I should contact him directly at that point.
