

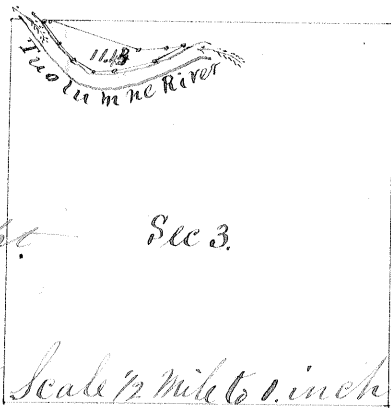

Field Notes.

Beginning at the U. S. Meander Post on the North
line of Section 3. Thence run on U. S. Meander line
S 73° E 19.77 ch, N $89\frac{1}{2}^{\circ}$ E 6.00 ch, N $79\frac{1}{2}^{\circ}$ E 4.00 ch to the
right bank of the Tuolumne River. Meander down
Stream. Run S 65° W 6.82 ch, S $76\frac{3}{4}^{\circ}$ W 9.00 ch, S $81\frac{3}{4}^{\circ}$ W 4.00
ch, N $59\frac{3}{4}^{\circ}$ W 4.66 ch, N 42° W 4.72 ch, N $39\frac{1}{4}^{\circ}$ W 6.00 ch to the
North line of Section 3. Thence run on Section line East
1.00 ch to the place of beginning.

Run by the true Meridian. Magnetic Variation
15 $^{\circ}$ 30' East.

Surveyed in accordance with the Act of the
Legislature concerning Swamp and Overflowed
Lands, approved April 18th 1859 and the
instruction of the Surveyor General.
