- Indicates a 3/4" I.P. f-Tag set.

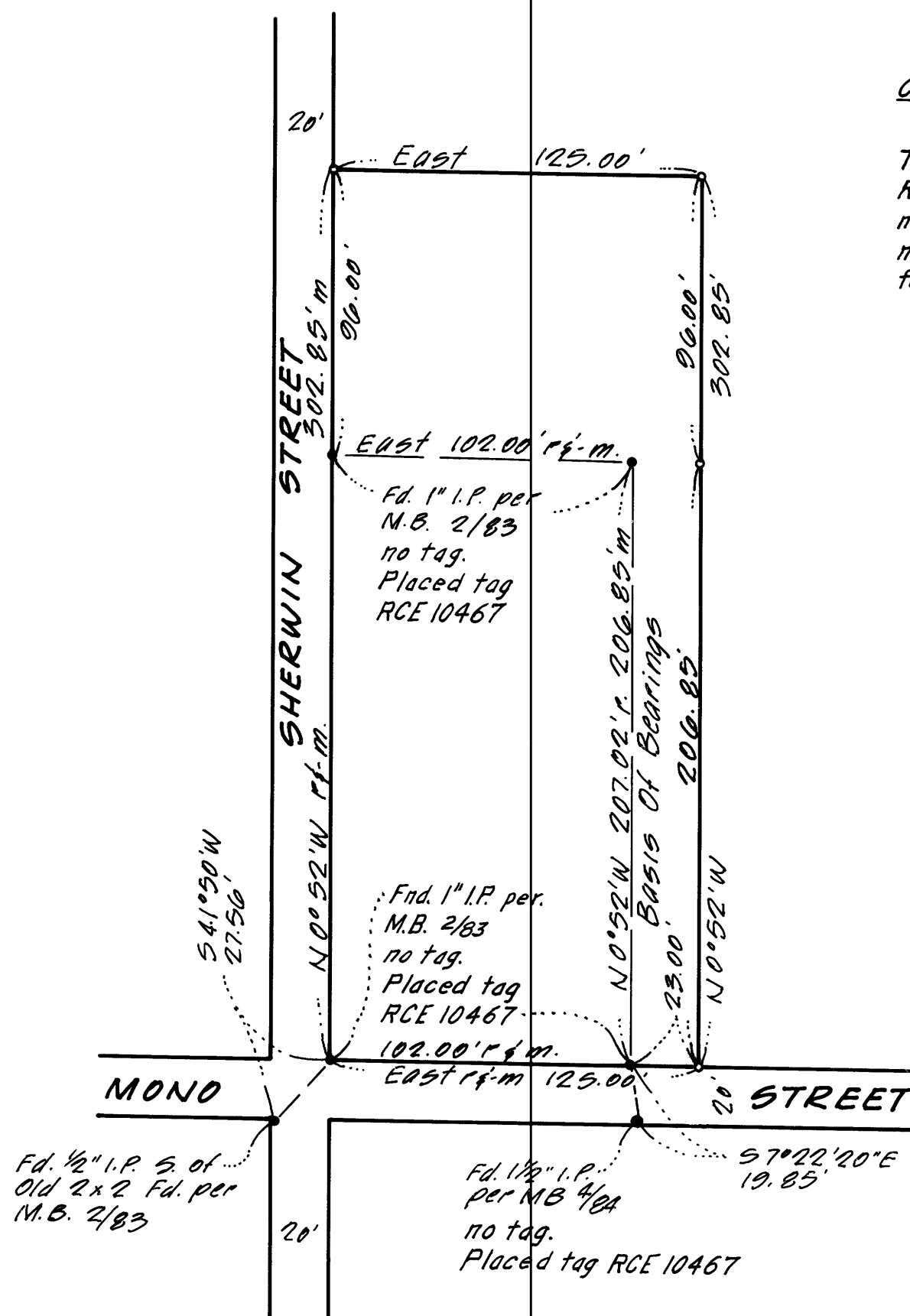

The unrecorded Record Of Survey No 36-4 which was prepared by me at the request of Mono County, in which some attempt was made to resolve the many conflicting surveys in this tract, shows street alignments on Mono & Sherwin Streets different than shown hereon. On said map the northwest corner is shown as being 0.22' east of the location shown hereon; the southeast corner 0.20' north and the southwest corner 1.13' east & 0.32' south. This survey was made prior to the survey for the County.

County Surveyor's Note:

The history of the surveys of Mammoth Camp Tract is long and involved. This map is based on R/S Map Book 2 - Page 83, and the validity of that map is open to question. As indicated in the surveyor's note, other surveys indicate alternate locations for some of the points.
